






# TOWARDS EXCELLENCE
















King Mahabali who visits Kerala at the time of Onam was portrayed in the form of a story by the grandmother of one of our students created curiosity and fascination among the children.






## MOTHER'S DAY


















# RAINY DAY




# GANDHI JAYANTHI CELEBRATION
