
Our school also bagged overall second place for Crossroads 2022, organised by the Global Public School

Our school won Raman Young Science Innovator Award – School of Science Excellence 2021-2022 for Raman Awards 2021.




Our school received Certificate of Cognitive Excellence by Wizclub 2022 for the outstanding performance from the students in the International HOTS Olympiad.


